1. SUBJECT

A. This MoU is made between Shuddhi NGO and NMDC to develop Digital Education by using Education Technology in Government Schools in order to equip students to have a sound career with knowledge of digital technology and experience of using technological equipments such as computers, laptops, iPads etc. so that they could get desired employment through their educational skills.

- **B.** The ground activities will focus on all-round development of students via upgrading all the Government Schools. The upgradation work will be carried out by providing Projectors & Led Screens in Classrooms, and iPads or Laptops to all the students and teachers. Shuddhi will also carry out training programs for students and teachers to equip them with basic understanding of computers. Shuddhi will also train students and teachers of all the Government Schools about Online Google Classroom which helps classes communicate, saves time, and make students and teachers stay organized.
- C. Shuddhi NGO has partnered with Google and Google Classroom Software will be provided free of cost to every teacher and student via Shuddhi. Students and Teachers will also be provided free of cost email ids in the form of student-name@shuddhi.org or teacher-name@shuddhi.org so that they can use Digital Classroom Technology with ease and can share projects, reports, files, etc and even can write exams and get digital grades. Students and teachers can easily communicate and share courses and teachings with each other via email and free 30GB online google drive storage. This combination of Digital Hardware in the form of laptops and Led Screens, and Online Classroom Software with latest education technology will be provided free of cost and not only will help students and teachers to go ahead with digital education, but will also save paper and will help us in saving our environment.
- **D.** Additionally, the scheme shall comprise from motivating the parents to send their wards to the Govt. schools for having education as well as our combined initiatives with them by imbibing the wards to develop other skills which includes educational counselling, psychological counselling, career counselling, how to have a better quality of living, making them aware about the various rights which have been provided by the Constitution of India to the citizens of our country and above all getting them perfected on ground in order to make children stand on their own feet.

2. COMMITMENTS

Party A (Shuddhi NGO) commits to provide:

- A. Basic computer skills to Students and Teachers who are not aware of computer
- B. Intermediate skills for those students who are having basic knowledge about computer
- C. Skills about hardware and technicality of computer
- **D.** Developing the knowledge of internet and the benefits which can be taken by the knowledge of internet
- **E.** Designing courses in computer and digital training of teachers

- **F.** Various other programmes for students who want to make their career in the field of computer, coding, or technology will be provided free of cost skill development training for employability in future
- **G.** free of cost Teaching students and teacher about digital technologies by providing every student and teacher an iPad or a Laptop such that they benefit by using Shuddhi NGO Online Classroom Technology
- **H.** Students and teachers will also be taught about BHIM App for digital payments, Swachh Bharat App to upload grievances to the local Government, and how to fill online forms in different government websites to avail several basic services.
- I. Awareness of child's parents to send their wards to school
- **J.** Motivating parents to send their wards into Gali schools/Shuddhi Centre of Education/Government Schools in their area who are not wishing to send their wards to schools.
- **K.** Explaining parents about the long term benefit of education of their wards for the betterment of their life and the use of digital education in day-to-day- life.
- **L.** Giving details about the kinds of employment which students can get after having digital education and benefits of using education technology in education.

Party B (NDMC) commits to:

- **A.** Provide permission to Shuddhi NGO to implement, install, configure and run all the digital equipments required in the classrooms, permission to distribute laptops or iPads to Students and Teachers.
- B. Provide all the possible help and support for successful implementation of this project.
- C. Provide permission to related government authorities for unforeseen circumstances that might occur in the future and provide all the possible help and support required to Party-A (Shuddhi NGO)

3. POLICIES

- **A.** This project will benefit students, teachers and also the whole community as this education project will also integrate several other sectors and delve further covering various thematic areas such as Girl Education, Learning enhancement for students, Mid Day Meal, School Infrastructure, Vocational training and Employability Skills.
- **B.** Shuddhi NGO is a Non-Profit Organisation and will implement the whole project with complete transparency and professionalism.
